It is also necessary to be sure that the following materials are all included to be eligible for a scholarship.***

1. Application with all sections completed. (Extra pages may be added if you do not have enough room on the application for your complete response.)
2. Latest transcript (It may be a copy.) – of your latest grades.
3. A one page typewritten statement describing:
 - a. How the church has been important in your life.
 - b. Your academic and career goals.
 - c. Your expectations of college life (or other institution).
 - d. Why you are a good candidate for an AUMC Scholarship.
4. A recent photograph, non-returnable.
5. Upon receipt of a scholarship, the check must be cashed within 3 months or the check will no longer be valid. Checks will not be re-issued.

*** Failure to submit all above materials will result in the elimination of your application from consideration by the scholarship committee.**
